



CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

11TH HUMBOLDT-PRINCETON GRADUATE CONFERENCE IN PHILOSOPHY

August 19-20, 2022, Berlin

All philosophy graduate students enrolled at Princeton or Humboldt are eligible to apply, including MA students at Humboldt. Contributions from all areas of philosophy are welcome, but should be accessible to people who do not specialize in the respective sub-field.

The conference will feature presentations by five graduate students from Princeton and five graduate students from Humboldt. Each presentation session will take 70 minutes: 30 minutes for presentation, 10 minutes for peer commentary, and 30 minutes for discussion. Each speaker will be asked to comment on one other paper.

Please submit an anonymized abstract (300-500 words) to <u>pr.hu.conference@gmail.com</u> by March 31th. Abstracts submitted by students from Humboldt will be reviewed at Princeton and *vice versa*. Please indicate in the subject line of your email whether you are a Princeton or a Humboldt student (e.g. "Submission (Humboldt)"). Notification of acceptance will be sent out around April 10th.
